

 - October 18th Supper Meeting:
 - Had three committee members & 4 interested people attend (2 WESTTA, 1 CUPE, 1 Support Staff). We reviewed feedback from Oct. 3rd and looked at trends for next year's planning. Assistant Superintendent stated that two days of Treaty Training are mandated for next year and it would be easiest to train all staff together. The trainers weren't available in September but may be for the traditional WSD PD Day. Waiting to hear but we may need to take a different approach to our involvement. UPDATE:

 Response from M. Fenn: Oct. 2nd has been booked for Treaty Training. "We can sure hold one of the common PD days for the work that the PD committee wants to do....Overall, I think there is still a PD day to plan, just not for October 2,d. And as soon as we have a more firm idea of where the dates line up with the calendar and any changes that may or may not happen we can let you know!"
 - This may be a starting point to say: We can see the PD Committee moving in a different direction.

- Shawna and I attended the MTS WSH Seminar on October 28th and the MTS/MSBA training session November 9th in Winkler.
- o I am exploring the option to take a second session on November 1 in Winnipeg as a co-chair of the Workplace Safety and Health Committee.
- o The next WSD WSH meeting and inspection is Dec. 14, 2023. Plan to bring up:
 - I learned investigations are required for serious incidents or any accident requiring medical assistance. But I don't yet see those report yet. I'm curious about how this system works.
 - Want to bring up psychological safety audit tool at next WHS meeting.
 - Both employee co-chairs are in favour of increasing time for inspections and meeting.
 - We will continue to discuss the exemption application.

- Shawna met with Danny Rocha Nov. 6th to discuss the estimate and plans for a website redesign.
 Some of the exciting possibilities: use the westta.ca domain name, have member only access so we can post our minutes, blog updates, sign up for events, etc. as well as have Executive only

- access, and making the Coverage Beyond Regular Duty form more efficient. He would also help develop a strategy for keeping the website current! Launch date would be WESTTA AGM.
- PR Grant application was sent in on Nov 7th requesting 67% of the costs for the website redesign project. We will wait for approval before submitting a 50% down-payment and beginning the work.

 - Last year's monthly resources are up on the WESTTA website. They need some tweaking and then will be shared with members.
 - o Demaris will prepare a profile and email it to all schools to let them know about her and what she wants to help with.

 - I attended the Presidents council meeting on October 21st, 2023. The next presidents' council check in is on December 4th which I plan on attending. I will continue to support the President when needed.
